The 2023 Celebrate Skating Competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the [current rulebook](#), as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating [website](#).

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules.

Skaters must be a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a Learn to Skate USA member, a member of a collegiate club

### **Deadline**

The deadline to register is Friday, December 23, 2022. Secure online registration will be provided by [Entryeeze](#). **No late entries will be accepted.** Entry fees will not be refunded after the registration deadline unless no competition exists or the event is cancelled. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals. Processing fees will not be returned.

### **Eligibility/ Test Level**

All Snowplow Sam and Learn to Skate USA skaters in Basic 1-6 must skate at the highest level passed or one higher and NO official U.S. Figure Skating tests may have been passed including Moves in the Field or individual dances.

Competition level is the highest test passed as of the entry deadline in the discipline the skater is entering. Skaters may skate up one level but may not skate down in any event.

Events will be divided as closely as possible by age, should the number of entries warrant more than one group.

Adult Events: All age classes may be divided or combined depending on the number of entries and at the discretion of the chief referee and/or the competition committee.

All offered Adult events qualify for the Adult Competition Series. More information and how to register for the series can be found [here](#).

### **SkateSafe Compliance**

### **Mandatory Athletes**

Athletes age 18+ as of the competition start date who will be competing on a team (i.e. TOI, synchro, etc.) with at least one minor athlete must complete SkateSafe training.

Minor athletes who turn 18 mid-season are encouraged to seek parental consent to take the online SkateSafe training early to avoid any disruptions in their ability to participate as the training is required upon turning 18. The athlete will not be SkateSafe compliant until they have completed the training and their Members Only portal reflects completion. ### **Coaches**

To be an eligible coach at a non qualifying competition, coaches must meet the compliance requirements listed below and verified by U.S. Figure Skating.

- Coach/Choreographer Compliance Requirements (domestic/non-foreign)
- Learn to Skate USA Instructor Compliance Requirements (Compete USA events only)
- Foreign Coach/Choreographer Compliance Requirements
  - Required to present the LOC with a letter from their federation verifying they are a member in good standing.

### **Liability**

### **Judging System**

The 6.0 judging system will be used for all events with the exception of all showcase and TOI, where CJS will be used.

### **Music Submission**

All skaters must upload their music to entryeeze by January 6, 2023. Music will only be played from the music uploaded to entryeeze and CDs will only be used as a backup if there is a technical difficulty. Competitors must have a copy of their competition music on CD kept rinkside in the event of a technical difficulty.

### **Facilities**

Celebrate Skate will be held at the C.E. Orr Arena at 22550 Milton Dr., Euclid, OH 44123. The entrance to the rink is located off of Babbitt Road. There is one ice surface that is 185'x85'.

## **Livestream**

C.E. Orr Arena is a Live Barn venue. If you cannot make it to the rink, you can stay connected to the competition by watching all the events live and On Demand. ## **Locker Rooms**

It is recommended that skaters come dressed and ready, however locker rooms will be available. Locker rooms and changing areas are for athletes only, and will be labeled with regard to specific use and where identified will be gender specific. An exception will be made for athletes 11 years old and younger that will allow for one parent of the same sex to assist their child immediately prior to and after their skating event(s). ## **Video and Photography**

No professional photo or video will be available. NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY is permitted during a performance.

## **U.S. Figure Skating Travel Policy**

All travel must strictly adhere to two-deep leadership requirements. An adult participant cannot transport a minor athlete one-on-one and two-deep leadership requirements must be adhered to at all times during in-program travel, by transporting at least two minors or a second adult participant. An adult participant cannot share a hotel room or other sleeping arrangement with a minor athlete(s). ## **Check-In**

Check-in will be open one hour before the first event on the morning of the competition and run through the last event of the day. Check-in will be set up

by the front door in the lobby. Athletes should check-in at least 45 minutes prior to their event.

### **Schedule**

Competitors may be scheduled at any time during the announced date of the competition. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available after the close of entries and approximately one week prior to the competition on the Celebrate Skate Entryeeze homepage. All skaters and coaches will be notified via email once available.

### **Practice Ice**

Practice ice will be available at the C.E. Orr Arena on Friday January 20 from 6-8pm and will be available to purchase on Entryeeze.

### **Awards**

All participants in Snowplow Sam through Free Skate 6 and Adult Basic Skills compulsory elements, without music, will receive ribbons, designated 1st through 4th and all others will receive honorable mention ribbons. Snowplow Sam through Free Skate 6 programs with music, Beginner through Preliminary Plus and Adult Program events with music will receive medals for 1st through 3rd and ribbons for all other places. The Euclid Basic Skills Trophy will be awarded to the rink (Club and LTS entries combined) earning the most points. The Greg Taylor Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the male skater placing first in the highest Basic Skills Event.

### **Results**

The starting orders and live results will be available via the IJS live scoring link through USFS, which will be provided at a later time through email and updated on entryeeze.
